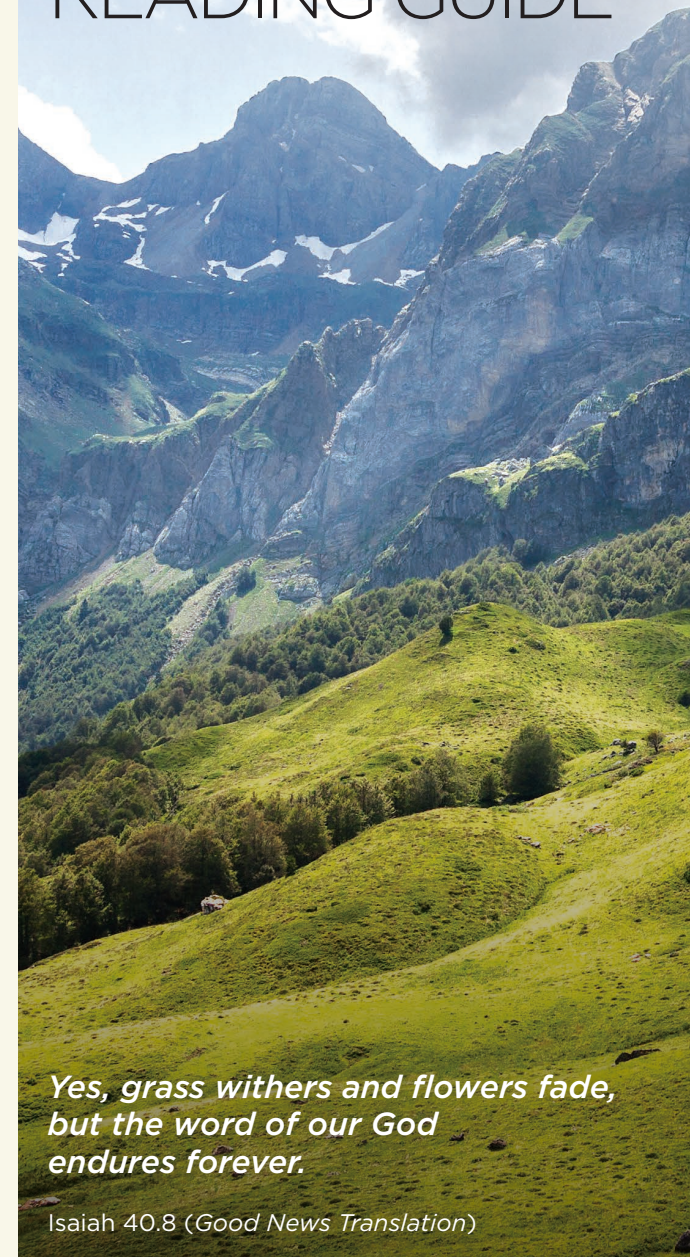


2015 DAILY BIBLE READING GUIDE

Respond to the passage. Speak to God directly about what’s on your mind and heart. Look for ways to live out what you’ve uncovered.

Orthodox Christians will observe Holy Week from April 5-11, and celebrate Pascha (Easter) on April 12, and may substitute the readings from March 29-April 4 in place of the readings for April 5-11 and substitute the readings from April 5-11 in place of the readings for April 12-18. These substitutions will enable the Passion and Resurrection readings to coincide with the Orthodox dates.

Orthodox Christians will observe Ascension Day on May 21 and Pentecost on May 31.
